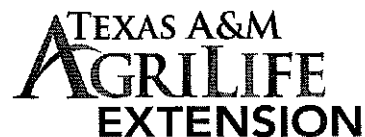


SOUTH PLAINS - DISTRICT 2 4-H

The District 2 4-H Program is pleased to announce an opportunity for county 4-H programs to have volunteers certified as coaches in shotgun, archery or pistol, and rifle. The training and certification will be conducted on October 15th and 16th in Seminole, TX at the Old Seminole Junior High Building (601 SW Ave B, Seminole). The training will begin with registration at 8:30 am on Saturday, October 15th, and conclude on Sunday at noon.

Registration will open on Monday, September 26th and close on Friday, October 7th at midnight via 4-H Connect, <https://texas.4honline.com/>. **ALL PARTICIPANTS MUST HAVE A CURRENT AND APPROVED 4-H CONNECT PROFILE TO REGISTER. PLEASE ALLOW AT LEAST 2 WEEKS TIME FOR BACKGROUND CHECK AND VOLUNTEER APPROVAL PRIOR TO THE REGISTRATION DEADLINE.** Registration is non-refundable, but may be transferred to another person within the same county 4-H program.

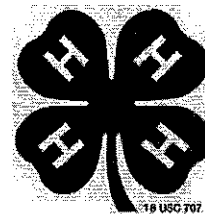

Listed below are the categories individuals can register for:

- 1) **Coach** - If the individual will lead the program, or have direct supervision of youth they should register for this category. A coach must be 21 or older. Cost is \$100 and two meals will be provided. The participant must register on 4-H Connect, and be a screened volunteer.
- 2) **Assistant Coach** - If the individual is between the ages of 14-20, they can assist a certified coach. Cost is \$100 and two meals will be provided. They must also register on 4-H Connect, and be a screened volunteer. If under 18 years of age, the individual must be accompanied to the training by a certified coach or parent.
- 3) **Certified Coach** - coaches who are already certified can attend at no charge if they are accompanying an assistant or teen coach. Two meals will be provided. These individuals should email amhart@ag.tamu.edu to confirm their attendance. **Registration on 4-H Connect is not required.**
- 4) **Extension Personnel** - All extension personnel are welcome to attend at no charge. Two meals will be provided. Extension personnel should email amhart@ag.tamu.edu to confirm their attendance. Registration on 4-H connect is not required. A complete agenda will be sent to those who register. If you have questions, let me know. This training will be offered statewide. Classes will consist of 20 participants per discipline. Registration will be on a first come/first served basis.

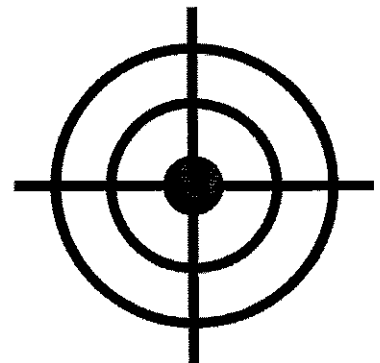
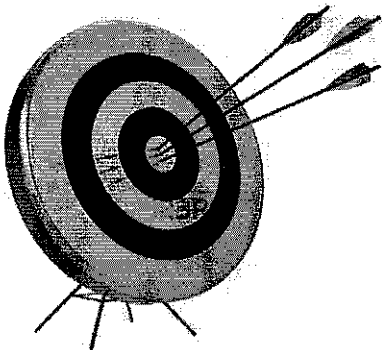


D-2 Shooting Sports Coach/Leader Training



Disciplines: Archery, Pistol, Rifle and Shotgun

Dates:	October 15-16, 2016, the training will begin at 8:30 a.m. on Saturday and continue into that evening. Training will continue on Sunday and end around noon.
Location:	Old Seminole Junior High Building (601 SW Ave B, Seminole)
Registration:	Opens Sept. 26 th on 4-H Connect. All registrants must be enrolled as 4-H adult volunteers on 4-H Connect and have a current Youth Protection background check. Cost is \$120/registrant which includes meals from Saturday lunch and supper, and 4-H Curriculum.
Registration Deadline:	October 7 th , 2016: late registration from Oct. 8 th -12 th for \$140/registrant.
Training:	The training will include classroom education and live firing exercises covering shooting and coaching principles, curriculum training, 4-H basics, and more.

WHAT TO BRING WITH YOU TO THE TRAINING:

- 3-Ring Binder (2" or larger recommended)
- Writing materials and extra paper for notes
- Highlighters if you use them to stress points
- Eye protection (shooting glasses or goggles) – recommended for archery, mandatory for all other disciplines
- Ear protection (plugs or muffs) mandatory for shotgun and pistol disciplines
- Comfortable outdoor clothing, including a cap or hat suitable for the prevailing weather and be prepared for cold weather, bring sunscreen
- Range chair if desired
- Open mind ready to learn and share
- Rain Jacket and Umbrella (Just In Case)

SHOTGUN DISCIPLINE PARTICIPANTS:

- 20 or 12 gauge shotgun, any action type
- Ammunition pouch or vest
- Bring 4 boxes of ammunition

ARCHERY DISCIPLINE PARTICIPANTS:

- All shooting equipment will be provided at the training
- Personal bows may be taken and used

PISTOL DISCIPLINE PARTICIPANTS:

- All shooting equipment will be provided at the training
- Ammunition will be provided
