

Private Applicator Training

Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service, Bexar County and Texas Department of Agriculture are offering certification and recertification training for private pesticide applicators. The purpose of this training is to obtain a Private Applicator License from Texas Department of Agriculture. This license will enable the applicator to purchase and apply state limited use and federally restricted chemicals on his land or land he has control of for the purpose of production of agricultural commodities. All farm and ranch operators who **do not** have a Private Applicator's License to purchase "**restricted use**" pesticides (such as 2, 4-D, Grazon P+D, Tordon 22K, etc.) **will need** to attend this training.
