



Supplies Needed


Fleece print 2 yds.
 Fleece solid 2 yds.
 Scissors or rotary cutter and mat

Tape measure
 Straight or safety pins
 Masking Tape

Directions

Start with two complimentary pieces of fleece material that are the same size. We recommend 2 yds. but you can make your blanket any size you like up to the width of the material. You will end up with a blanket that is 8 inches shorter than the material you start with so keep that in mind.

1. Place fleece fabric wrong sides together. Using straight pins or safety pins pin the material together about eight inches in from the edges. This is to keep your blanket in place as you work.
2. Cut off the rough selvage edge on both sides. Trim only as much as necessary, usually not more than 2 inches on each side. At this point, make sure that your cut sides are relatively straight and the same size. They don't have to be perfect!
3. Use a 4" X 4" cardboard square template to cut out a 4" square on each corner. Place pieces of masking tape approximately 5" in from the edges of the blanket to be used as a cutting guide. See diagram.



4. To make the fringe, cut 4" into fleece at 1" intervals around all sides of both top and bottom. See diagram.
5. Starting on one side, start tying your knots. Tie knots on every other fringe around the blanket. Turn the whole blanket over and tie the remaining fringes into knots until your blanket is finished. Remove the masking tape.
