Fee Structure for Year 2017 - 2018

Description of the Facility:

This is a 2+/- Acre open facility designed as a Demonstration, Training, Education, and Research Center for OSSF and Water Reuse Technologies and Systems. For manufacturers of OSSF and Water Treatment Equipment Display Unit \$2,000 per year

For Education, Extension, Training Activities \$50 per student

Research/Testing Activities:

- Experimental design consultation (max 40 hours) \$2,000
- Experimental design consultation (additional hours) \$75/hr.
- Set-up (max 3 days) \$1,500
- Set-up (additional days) \$500/day
- Conduct experiment / testing and collect data \$50/hr.
- Data analysis and report preparation \$75/hr.
- Dismantle (max 3 days) \$1,500
- Dismantle (additional days) \$500/day
- Material and Outside Labor when needed Cost + 20%
- All other activities not included above
 - Labor cost per hour \$50
 - Travel – mileage + per diem + motel @ standard rates
 - Material Cost + 20%
- TOTAL COST WILL DEPEND ON TYPE OF ACTIVITY, SCOPE OF WORK, LENGTH OF PROJECT, TAMU OVERHEAD, AND OTHER FACTORS.
