This 3-day school will prepare individuals to become professional sheep shearers. Students will be instructed on proper animal handling techniques both on and off the shearing floor. Instruction will be provided on proper use of professional shearing equipment and tool maintenance. Shearing school participants will receive training on proper wool handling and preparation. Participants will receive a sheep shearing handbook and DVD.
