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WAIVER BY STUDENTS ENROLLED IN SOUTHERN GREAT PLAINS DAIRY CONSORTIUM-TEACHING DAIRY ACTIVITIES IN REGARD TO MEDICAL INSURANCE AND SERVICES

The Southern Great Plains Dairy Consortium-Teaching does not provide medical services to students enrolled in the consortium activities. If an accident, injury or illness occurs, the student must have his/her own transportation to a health care facility. In the event a student experiences an injury that is beyond the scope of the local services, the student will be referred to an outside facility at the personnel expense of the student, even if the injury occurs while participating in a formal course, special problem, field demonstration or research project.

In order to participate in hands-on dairy activities, in either a formal course, special problems or field application, all students must be aware of the inherent risks of working with dairy cattle and be willing to assume responsibility for any injuries. All students working with dairy cattle, either as part of a formal class, special problem, or as part of a field application are strongly encouraged to secure personal medical insurance. Students who are enrolled in these activities will assume the risks associated with dairy cattle and will be responsible for payment of any medical expenses.

I have read the above information. I also understand it is my responsibility to secure personal insurance coverage, and the Southern Great Plains Dairy Consortium-Teaching will not be responsible for medical expenses resulting from injury while working with dairy cattle in a formal course, special problem, field demonstration or research project.

Additionally, I have received instruction on the safe methods for working with dairy cattle for this class.
