

Texas varsity, UAS, Dharwad, ink pact

» Texas University, in association with University of Agricultural Sciences (UAS), Dharwad, will start two institutes in the State to strengthen agriculture and horticulture sectors. A high-level meeting chaired by Chief Minister Siddaramaiah at his home office Krishna, on Saturday, gave its nod for establishing the two institutes.

A centre for excellence in 'food for health' will come up in Bangalore and the other on agriculture development at Dharwad. A proposal has been sent to the State government to sanction necessary funds for establishing the two institutes.
