**Analysis Includes: pH, NO<sub>3</sub>, P, K, Ca, Mg, Na, S and Conductivity**

**Limit of 5 samples per person.    Afterwards samples will be \$6.00 ea.**

**(Soil testing is for pasture & rangeland)**
