The **Texas A&M Natural Resources Institute** just opened the *Texas Landowner Survey*. Released every 5 years, it seeks to understand private landowner needs and concerns in operating and managing their land.

The voluntary survey covers topics ranging *from land* management, land loss and fragmentation, and landowner challenges and preferences, all of which serve to improve efforts in private land conservation.

The mostly multiple-choice survey should take *about 20-30* minutes to complete using a tablet, laptop or desktop computer and about 5 minutes longer using a cell phone.

An outcome of the landowner survey is finding better ways to serve Texas landowners through programming and technical guidance to meet their land management needs.
