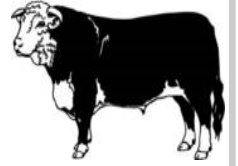
PEEWEE SHOWMANSHIP RULES:

Ride night events are only for the contestants registered for competition in the Bell County Youth Fair Horse Show and only the contestant horses that are the primary or alternate horses signed up for the events in 2016. We will be checking for Coggins so have copies of current negative Coggins test results on all the horses you bring. Contestants must register each night and present Coggins paperwork to ride in the arenas.

We do not allow alcohol or smoking at anytime in the barn and no alcohol can be consumed in parking lot. Because this is an equine event, absolutely no dogs will be allowed on the grounds.

Strip Piecing Doll Quilt

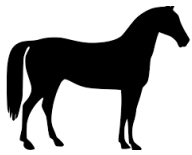

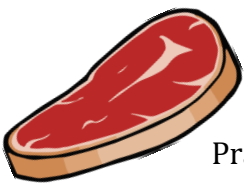
Livestock Judging Team
