4-H Enrollment

4-H Enrollment started <u>August 15th</u>!!! All enrollment is done via 4-H Connect. You can access 4-H Connect by going to our 4-H website at <u>http://agrilife.org/bell4h/</u> and clicking on the 4-H Connect icon.

To maintain the level of programming and opportunities in the Texas 4-H and Youth Development Program, an annual participant fee is implemented for each 4-H member (excluding Clover Kids). The participant fee is \$20 if enrolled from <u>August 15th to October 31st</u>, November 1st the participant fee will increase to \$25.

Please do not worry if you are still pending at the county level once you have enrolled. The county office will try to keep up as best as we can by approving them at least once a week. As long as you complete your enrollment, you are in the system and good for enrollment and BCYF requirements. Enrollment dues must be paid by an electronic payment.

- You MUST attend 2 meetings to participate in the BCYF. <u>You MUST sign in on the sign in sheets for it to count.</u>
- 2 meetings will be allowed from <u>August 1, 2017 to December 31, 2017</u> this year. No meetings will be allowed in January to use for the 2 meeting rule.
- All 4-H members MUST be enrolled by <u>December 6, 2017</u> to participate in the BCYF. However, the fee will go up after October 31st so do it quickly.
