- This entry form is **TWO PAGES**. You must turn in ALL pages to be entered and eligible to compete.
- All entries are due to the Bell County Extension Office by **5:00 p.m. on Friday, March 7, 2014**.
- **NO** late entries will be accepted.
- No entry fee is required
- 4-H youth may enter only ONE category. Except if you are entering quiz bowl and educational presentations/public speaking.
- 4-H youth CANNOT enter this part of the contest (edu. Presentations/public speaking) AND share the fun! However you can enter Share the Fun and Quiz Bowl.
- All categories allow one or two participants; so, you may compete as an individual or a team for any of the Roundup categories.
- In order to compete as a team, you may move a junior up to an intermediate team if necessary. The junior will then be competing with intermediates. You may NOT move any 4-H'ers down to a younger age category (for example: you cannot move an intermediate down to be on a team with a junior). In addition, no one may move up to compete in the senior age division. Clover Kids MUST participate as Clover Kids.
