1: Scuba Diving watch which has the most depth at 500M. Has best crystal type. Has date and quartz and automatic movement which is very accurate but not the best. Nice steel bracelet for both formal and informal. No world time and more expensive than 4.

2: Scuba Diving watch which has a depth of 300M. Has best crystal type. Has date and mechanical and automatic movement which is a nice craftsmanship but is not very accurate in time because the time needs to be winded regularly and loses an hour a year. Nice stainless steel bracelet for both formal and informal but not as nice as #1. No world time and more expensive than 4 and 1.

3: Not a diving watch at only 100 M. Most expensive in class.
