Special Notes:

- Houston entries must be notarized. Parking Passes for Houston are based on total club/chapter entries and the limited number of passes will be shared by exhibitors.
- Health Papers are required for all species at Fort Worth and required only for breeding livestock at San Angelo, San Antonio, Houston, and Austin.
- The Quality Counts Certification must be completed once as a Junior aged member (8th grade and younger) and once as a Senior aged member (9th grade and older). The test can be at <https://agrilife.org/qualitycounts/verification/>.
- Only exact cash, check, or money order will be accepted as payment. Returned checks will make the entry invalid.
- Livestock exhibitors who attend at least one major show will qualify for a \$50.00 reimbursement at the end of the show season. Exhibitors may receive only one reimbursement per 4-H year regardless of the number of entries or species they exhibit.
