You may enter one horse in each class in the Qualifying Divisions and Futurity Divisions.

Please note that if you enter Class 5 Trail, you may not enter Class 24 Stock Horse Trail. You may only enter one or the other, not both.

Please note that if you enter Class 1 Showmanship at Halter, you may not enter Class 27 Stock Horse Showmanship. You may only enter one or the other, not both.

Please note that if you enter Class 26 Stock Horse Horsemanship, you may not enter Class 3 Western Horsemanship. You may only enter one or the other, not both.

Please note that if you enter Class 27 Stock Horse Showmanship, you may not enter Class 1 Showmanship at Halter. You may only enter one or the other, not both.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Be sure that you and your parent/guardian read and sign the Waiver, Indemnification, and Medical Treatment Authorization Form. This form can be found at https://agrillife.org/d84h/files/2019/05/2019_D8_4-H_Horse_Show_Waiver.pdf.

The **completed, signed waiver forms and Coggins papers** will need to be **scanned as a pdf** and uploaded to 4-H Connect during the entry process.

You can scan and upload your signed waiver form and Coggins papers now OR you can sign it and take a hard copy to your County Extension Agent for him/her to scan and upload.

All file uploads must be in pdf format. No jpg files will be accepted.

Current TAHC regulations state that a documented, negative, 12-month test for EIA is required for all horses which are co-mingled. This includes both those entered in the show and those brought along for any other purpose. EIA documents will be checked at the District 8 Horse Show. Any additional regulations from TAHC that become effective after printing this show information will also be in effect. If necessary, information will be distributed through County Extension Agents.

STALLS: Stalls are available on a first come/first serve basis. Stalls will be an estimated \$20 per stall/per day. Your entry does not guarantee you a stall. Shavings are estimated \$6 per bag. Contestants may not bring their own shavings. Prices are subject to change at the discretion of the facility.
RV Hookups are available for \$20 per night.
