#### I. JUNIOR LIVESTOCK SHOW

#### A. General

- Entry deadline: Bell County 4-H Deadline is November 6th!
- Livestock Premium List and Entry Applications will be available at FWSSR.COM on September 15.

## • Please fill out Entry Applications completely including appropriate signatures prior to submitting entries.

- Entry applications are legal, binding documents. An exhibitor who makes a material misrepresentation subjects themselves to being barred from all further competition.
- Residue Avoidance Program remains in effect.
- All entries in the Junior Livestock Show must be exhibited by the owner/exhibitor, except when the exhibitor has more than one entry in a class or cannot be present to show their own animal due to circumstances beyond their control. In these cases, a substitute showman may exhibit the animal provided that the substitute showman meets all Junior Exhibitor criteria and is approved by the Superintendent of that department. A substitute showman may not exhibit animals for an owner/exhibitor participating in other events or activities (UIL competitions, school sports, etc.) or just being absent from the competition. If the exhibitor is scholastically ineligible to participate, as determined by the respective School District, the exhibitor and their entries are ineligible for competition.
- An animal will be disqualified from the show if it is being trimmed, fitted or dressed by anyone other than exhibitors, County Extension Agents or Agricultural Science Teachers from the State of Texas, or other feeders or leaders within the county or school district from which the animal is entered.
  - Any Junior animal entry which, when rubbed with a cloth or glove show residual evidence of artificial coloring, will be disqualified.



#### I. Junior Show General Information

Junior Show Entry: Entries are not considered complete unless they have been submitted online <u>and</u> credit card payment or check received on or before Bell County 4-H Deadline is November 6th! Incomplete entries (entries either not submitted online or credit card payment or check not received by December 1, 2023) will be assessed an additional 10% fee.

- i. Late Entries: For any Junior Show entries submitted online and credit card payment or check received from December 2-15, 2023, all standard entry fees will be doubled, if accepted.
- ii. Past Due Entries: For any Junior Show entries with payment postmarked or received from December 16, 2023, until the end of check-in for the respective show or contest, a late entry fee of \$250 per entry will be assessed, if accepted.

**Quality Counts:** To be eligible to compete in the Junior Breeding, Junior Commercial and/or Junior Market Shows, exhibitors will need Quality Counts verification. The Quality Counts verification number must be recorded on the online entry when entering the project. Please refer to the website <a href="https://agrilife.org/qualitycounts/">https://agrilife.org/qualitycounts/</a> for information on how to become verified.

#### **Breeding Show Ownership Deadlines:**

Registration Certificates will be used to verify ownership date for breeding animals with the exception of Crossbred Gilts, Commercial Ewes and Commercial Does. Animals must be registered in the Herdbook of their Association in only the name of the Junior owner(s) on or before the required ownership date (see below). Registration Certificates must state the name of the Junior owner(s) only. Registration Certificates that list any additional names besides the name(s) the entry is validated under will be disqualified. Registration Certificates must be available upon request.

Purchase, delivery, possession, transfer, and registration must all take place on or before the required ownership date. Original Registration Certificates must be available during the show at all times.

**Registered Sheep, Boer Breeding Goat:** October 1, 2023 (Must be validated through Breeding Sheep or Breeding Goat Validation, respectively, on or before October 31, 2023) Note\* Family validation is now allowed for breeding sheep and goats.   - NO cedar fiber allowed to be used in the Cattle Barn.
  - > Shredded cardboard and cedar fiber will still be used for Angora goats.
- o If you want to stall together, you must arrive at Salado Creek Property together.
- O There will be no pre-stalling for market lambs and goats.
- Exhibitor Campgrounds: Campground space will be extremely limited for most shows. Parents, CEAs, ASTs, adult leaders or their representatives are asked to assist in reducing the number of chairs from their respective county or chapter. No tables will be permitted to be set up in the Livestock Barns. Nothing will be allowed to be set up in designated Fire Lanes. Exhibitors must be aware of their surroundings and cognizant of others when making space for their campgrounds. Exhibitors abusing campground areas will be subject to disqualification.

#### GILTS –

- All Purebred gilts must have been farrowed between <u>June</u> 1 (not July) and September 15, 2023 inclusive. In 2024, Purebred gilt classes will be broken and shown by <u>weight</u>. Range: 200 350 lbs with 15 lb weigh-back.
- We will add <u>Hereford</u> gilts to our 2024 Junior Purebred Breeding Gilt Show. We would like to get an idea of how popular this breed may be in our show, but we do not want to prevent anyone from bringing two gilts of breeds currently eligible for scholarships. Therefore, we will allow exhibitors to enter a maximum of three (3) head in the Junior Purebred Gilt Show, BUT AT LEAST ONE (1) AND NO MORE THAN TWO (2) MUST BE A HEREFORD GILT. This will be enforced at Check-in. If anyone is found violating this rule, ALL entries will be disqualified. Hereford Gilts will not be eligible for a scholarship in 2024, but Premiums will be awarded.
- Additionally, we will be working with the swine registries to DNA test, at minimum, Breed and Reserve Breed Champions in the Purebred Gilt Show.
