Academic Eligibility & Excused Absences for 4-H Competitions and Activities

Academic eligibility is requested for extracurricular activities by the County Extension Agent and is approved or declined by the member's school. In addition to following this UIL rule, the Texas 4-H Youth Development Program has adopted a school change policy to stay consistent across educational systems. If a youth has a change in school status from public to private or home school, the member must adhere to a three (3) school-week waiting period before he/ she is eligible for participating in extracurricular activities.

All 4-H members must be officially enrolled (in an "active" status on 4-H Online) to be considered an official 4-H member. No excused absences can be requested for any youth who is not enrolled in the official 4-H enrollment system (4-H Online). If a member is participating in a 4-H event/competition, please contact the agent advising that project area at least two weeks in advance of the event to communicate when the child will be missing school. Major Show Entry Forms Deadline

The Bell County 4-H Major Show Entry Deadline is **November 6th!** We will be open from 8:00 AM - 6:00 PM on November 6th to accept entry forms. All required paperwork must be filled out completely and turned in with original signatures before the deadline. Emailed forms will not be accepted. Entries without payment will not be accepted. Exact cash or checks can be made payable to the Bell Livestock Coalition. If you would like to pay by credit card, a 3% fee will be added to cover service charges. As entry forms are released from the shows, a PDF version will be posted at <u>https://agrilife.org/bell4h/projects/4-h-livestock/</u>. You may fill and print the PDF versions at home. Also, paper copies of the entry forms will also be available at the Bell County Extension Office. To ensure that all entries from Bell County 4-H are processed and checked thoroughly,

2025 Major Show Swine Validation

Physical validation will be held at the **Bell County EXPO** on the dates listed below: **November 18th and November 25th from 4:00 – 7:00 pm**

- All Market Barrows, Registered Breeding Gilts, and Crossbred/Commercial Breeding Gilts will use the same RFID validation tag.
- Registered Gilt papers must be owned on or before November 30, 2024 and they must also be registered (litter registration, bottom left hand corner) on or before November 30, 2024. There are NO EXCEPTIONS on this! Please send a PDF copy of the <u>ORIGINAL</u> registration papers for the registered gilts you plan to validate to Sheryl.Long@ag.tamu.edu <u>PRIOR</u> to validation.
- ** A parent of the exhibitor must be present during major show validation. If there is a conflict, please notify Sheryl Long in advance so additional paperwork can be filled out prior to validation.**


