- 6. Sealed high school transcript/scholastic record **must** be attached to the application.
- 7. Application must include two (2) letters of recommendations. Letters <u>cannot</u> be from family members.

- 1. The scholarship winner will be announced in May.
- 2. A presentation may be given at the end-of-school awards program.
