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## General Rules

## AGEDIVISIONS:

There will be three age divisions. Divisions for all District Contests are determined as the age as of August 31, 2018. The age divisions are as follows (except for Smallbore Rifle):

- Juniors - $3^{\text {rd }}$ Grade (and 8 years old) $-5^{\text {th }}$ Grade
- Intermediates $-6^{\text {th }}-8^{\text {th }}$ Grade
- Seniors $-9^{\text {th }}-12^{\text {th }}$ Grade (has not surpassed their $18^{\text {th }}$ birthday as of August 31, 2018)

Smallbore Rifle age divisions will be in the Spring Round-Up Guide.
Juniors may move up to the Intermediate age division when participating on a team that has true intermediates (based on grades listed above) on it. No one may move up to the Senior age division.
