Senior Division: 9th – 12th Grade (ages 14-18)

Junior Division: 6th – 8th grade (ages 11-13)

Intermediate (Clover) Division: 4th -5th Grade (ages 9-10)

***We reserve the right to combine the Intermediate (Clovers) and Junior Divisions based on attendance.

We will allow teams and individuals to Compete Up, meaning younger contestants can move up **one** division (i.e., Junior up to Senior or Intermediate up to Junior, you will not be allowed to move an Intermediate up to Senior). **If a contestant is Competing Up a division, you must register them in the new division, you will NOT be able to change entries on the day of without paying additional fees. *****

You can Register your team through your County 4H Office and FFA Office Through Judging Card.

Registration fees are as follows

- \$25 per team from Thursday, January 2, 2020 – Sunday, March 29, 2020
- \$15 per individual from Thursday, January 2, 2020 – Sunday, March 29, 2020

Late registration will be as follows

- \$50 per team from Monday, March 30, 2020 – Friday, April 3, 2020
- \$25 per individual from Monday, March 30, 2020 – Friday, April 3, 2020

Day of registration is as follows

- \$60 per team on the morning of Sunday, April 5, 2020
- \$35 per individual on the morning of Sunday, April 5, 2020

This contest will be run along the same lines as the State 4H Hippology Contest

- 2 Horse Judging Classes – 100 points (50 points/class)
- 50 Question Slide Show Evaluation – 50 points
- 100 Question Multiple Choice Test – 125 points
 - 60 minuets. Juniors and Intermediate stop at designated spot
- 100 Question Station Identification – 125 points
 - 2 minuets per station
- Team Problem – 100 points
 - Contributes to team score only
 - Seniors Mandatory
 - Juniors and Intermediate Optional but highly encouraged
 - Team question(s) will be outlined on the detailed invitation
