2023 Walter Gerlach Livestock Show and Sale – January 20th – 28th (RULEBOOK)

Eligibility Rules (see Rule 15 of rulebook):

- Exhibitors must be an active member of an "invited" FFA Chapter or 4H Club (ASTA FFA, Helotes 4H LSO, LSP, and Unlimited Clubs, and Leon Springs 4H) <u>and</u> must reside in the Northside ISD or legally attend a NISD school during the entire feeding period and throughout the duration of the show. (See Rule 12 for animal eligibility).
- Exhibitor must attend an accredited private, home school, or public elementary or secondary school and has not yet graduated from high school (in the Northside school district boundaries)
- Exhibitor must personally feed and care for his/her animal for the entire duration of the feeding and fitting period.
- An exhibitor attending the NISD Alternative Center may not participate.
- An exhibitor who is a 5th year high school student may not participate.
- All exhibitors must be between the ages of 9 and 19 on August 31, 2022 or may be 8 years old and in 3rd grade on August 31, 2022.
- Exhibitors who are ineligible under Texas Education Code 33.081 "No Pass, No Play" are not allowed to participate in any WGLS activity, including the showing of a project and/or auction. Any project owned by an ineligible exhibitor is also ineligible for competition and auction. This includes Ag Mechanics entries.
