- A currently graduating high school senior with at least a 3.0 GPA
- Attending a Texas college on a full-time basis (minimum of 12 hours/semester) for the 2023-2024 academic year
- Pursuing and Agriculture-related decree (i.e. Animal Science, Animal Nutrition, Ag Development, Ag Education, Ag Business, Veterinary Medicine, etc.)

Jason Kreuger Memorial Scholarship- DEADLINE April 20th (APPLICATION)

- Resume or Student Biography (note high school achievements, honors, awards, activities, extra-curricular, community service, and 4-H/FFA involvements)
- Applicant essay which details applicant's dreams, ambitions, and future educational goals. Not to exceed 300 words.
- Two letters of recommendation (not from a family member)

Major Stock Show Validation Tattoo Information

This is a notice and a reminder to be diligent in checking cattle (steer and heifer) and sheep/goat tattoos. This includes both individual ID tattoos (breeding animals) and county number tattoos (market animals). The major shows **WILL** be checking all placing animals for tattoos for their respective required tattoos.

IMPORTANT NOTE: The majors have not been checking steer tattoos consistently in the past. Therefore, your families may not be accustomed to double-checking these prior to shows.

This is a reminder for ALL livestock exhibitor families to check tattoos and get them redone, if necessary, *before* the show. County-level state validation committees should be utilized to correct/replace tattoos that are not legible or absent.

All placing livestock that do not have a visible and/or legible tattoo will be disqualified at Texas major livestock shows. DNA collection will not be considered for tattoo discrepancies or the absence of tattoos.

<u>Upcoming Bexar County 4-H Open Horse Show Schedule (2022-2023)</u>

<u>Show Information:</u> Upcoming show information is available on the <u>Bexar 4-H Horse Leaders Facebook page</u>. 4-H member competing for end of the year awards & prizes MUST complete an academic eligibility form to remain eligible for competitive awards! Check back soon for 2022-2023 season!

Texas 4-H Horse Show Rule Changes (Updated Rules)

The State 4-H Horse Show Committee has voted on several rule changes for the 2023 year.

The major changes include:

- 1. Ranch Cutting will be added as a class in the stock horse division. This class will not count towards high point in the division. Exhibitors can show in both cutting and ranch cutting. (pg. 87)
- 2. District qualification will be removed; however, for safety reasons, futurity exhibitors must participate in a district horse show, district educational clinic, or other equivalent event where futurity project is present. Participation will be verified by the county extension agent on the State 4-H Horse Show entry form. (pg. 9). This change allows more flexibility for district programs to offer targeted experiences that are tailored to local needs; and allows more flexibility for 4-H families.
- 3. State 4-H Horse Show entries will be open earlier beginning May 1 and will remain open until July 1.
- 4. Ownership requirement amendment: lease horses will be allowed. Official Texas 4-H Horse Lease agreement must be signed by the exhibitor, horse owner, and county extension agent. Lease period must include, at minimum, May 1st to August 31st of the current 4-H Year. The lease form must be uploaded to 4HOnline at validation. (pg. 7) This is a significant change for horse project eligibility in Texas which the committee expects will result in an increase in participation at the State 4-H Horse Show. However, the anticipated increase in participation at the state show was not the primary goal when considering this change. In fact, the State 4-H Horse Show has seen a 10.7% increase in participation over the past 4 years. The objective in allowing lease horses is to make the show more inclusive for young horse enthusiasts who may not have the opportunity for horse ownership yet.
 - *Official lease agreement is under review and will be made available on the State 4-H Horse Show webpage when finalized. Anticipated availability by Friday 2/3.

Slingshot Challenge - DEADLINE February 24th (Information)


