


### **Calf Scramble Applications**

**Houston Livestock Show & Rodeo** Calf Scramble forms will be available soon. If Brazoria County 4-H has limited entries, then once the number of qualified and complete entries are received in the county office they will be sent on to Houston. Entries will be taken at the Major Show entry nights in November.



Major Show Entry night will be for the spring Major Shows: Fort Worth, San Antonio, Houston, San Angelo, and Austin. This year major show entry night will be set up differently than in the past. This year you will sit down with an Extension Agent who will directly enter you into the online system that night! This process will take a little longer than previous years, so please plan accordingly. We will have two entry nights. *If you plan on showing at Fort Worth you need to come to the first night!* You will not be able to enter FWSSR on the second date.

Wednesday, November 2nd from 4:00-6:00pm Tuesday, November 15<sup>th</sup> from 3:00-7:00pm

The entry applications are posted on each of the shows websites for you to print fill out and bring with you! (Houston's information is to be updated in the month of October. So keep on the lookout for that updated information. Please remember, tag orders, validation, turkey, and broiler order does not enter you in the Major Shows. You must still go through the entry process.













All exhibitors must be Quality Counts certified. 4-H members that turned 14 years old before September 1, 2016 will now need to take the senior test. Go to Quality Counts website - click on Texas Trail for the tutorial then Verification to take the test.
