Beginning December 26th, several Brazoria County offices will begin collecting discarded Christmas trees at their locations to be placed along the beachfront to help gather blowing sands, and build up dunes. After collecting the donations, volunteers and park staff will come together on January 19th, 2019 to position the trees along the beaches at Follett's Island and the Village of Surfside.
