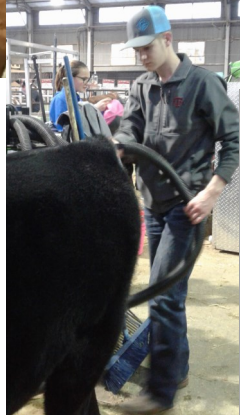

HOW TSC IS SUPPORTING 4-H IN YOUR COMMUNITY!

Since 2017, more than 50,000 4-H youth across America have had the opportunity to attend county-level development programs, camps and leadership conferences as a result of TSC's Paper Clover fundraiser. The Paper Clover campaign, is in-store and online twice a year and contributes to the success and development of local 4-H youth.

All of the funds raised are awarded to 4-H, with 10% awarded to National 4-H and 90% awarded to State 4-H Directors. With the exception of National 4-H's 10% allotment, all funds remain in the states they were raised in. Local 4-H leaders are encouraged to partner with their State Director on how their group can qualify for a portion of the funds raised.

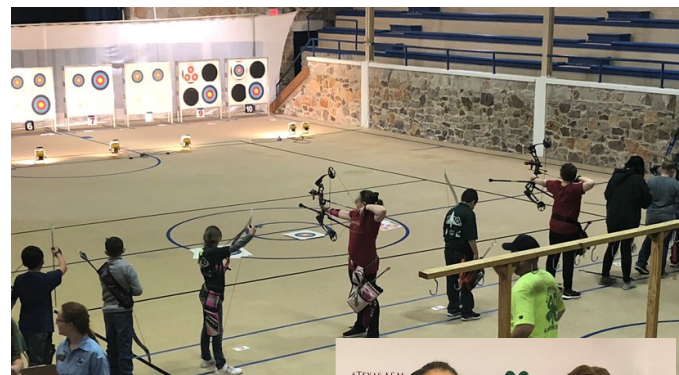
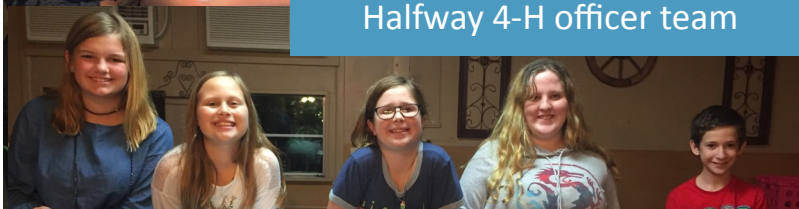

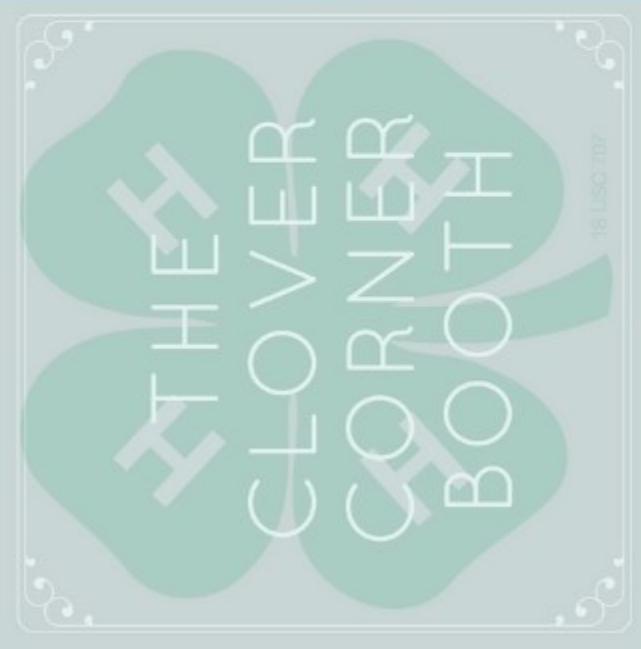
