 - A letter of recommendation from either your club leader or County Extension Agent
 - A letter of recommendation from your school counselor, a teacher, pastor, or a member of the community with whom you have worked.
 - A letter explaining what 4-H has meant to you and in what way your experiences in 4-H will impact your future.
 - Any other information you would like us to consider.
 - Attach a copy of your official transcript for grades.
