As you know Brazoria County 4-H holds two county wide fundraisers annually. It has always been our goal to have all clubs participate and support the fundraising effort, however, this is not the case for one reason or another. The Brazoria County 4-H program does not receive funding from the county, district, or state, thus the need for county fundraisers. Texas 4-H county programs must be self-supporting.

For many, many years we have very successfully sold pecans/nuts and plan to continue doing so. Our second fundraiser has been a raffle. The past half dozen years the raffle has changed from the long time club donations, to one big item - mule/trailer, to a gun raffle. While these raffles have made money, it has been increasingly difficult to sell the tickets with many other organizations holding big raffles.

This spring the Brazoria County 4-H Parents Association would like to try a new type of fundraiser. The Brazoria Bonanza would be a combination event that would have each club hosting a different activity. The big dream is to have a cattle show, livestock judging contest, food challenge, robotics, contest, and

other events occurring simultaneously. Some clubs could host the concession stand, silent auction, or a contest. Start talking about what your club would like to host. Save the Date April 18 for the Brazoria Bonanza
