# **Projects and Priorities**

During the March 3<sup>rd</sup> Coalition meeting, there was no breakout room discussion for this topic area. A brief presentation included instructions to start a pool of project ideas, including questions to guide the exercise:

- Is there an education or outreach opportunity?
- How can we benefit multiple watersheds or communities?
- Are we the group to implement the idea?

The Coalition will aim to complete six education/outreach efforts before Thanksgiving 2021.

## Review project opportunities and refine project strategies and actions.

Project idea – **Tire drop off/reporting** – Share locations/instructions on how to dispose of used tires or who to notify when you see them abandoned.

- Tires are an issue
- What do you do if you see tires on the roadway?
- Free locations to drop off in Galveston County City of Dickinson drop off is reoccurring
- Education to let people know about drop off and reporting

## Project idea – Video or art contest for students on trash/illegal dumping

- Galveston County fair is in April; Brazoria County fair is in the fall
- Earth Day events; other days to plan for
- Potential to collaborate with 4H?

## Project idea – Work with other groups on trash/plastics in waterways

- Plastics Pollution Prevention Partnership (P3)

# Project idea - Large items/Vessels pickup/drop off

- How to reach boaters? Registration at TPWD? Signage at boat ramps? Private boat ramps?
- How much participation do drop off events get? Are there any coming up? Brazoria County had a recent event for vessel collection
- Vessels are abandoned after large storms, after accidents, not always planned
- Is GLO the one to call when you see abandoned vessels?
- GBF does a removal event
- Does either county have materials to share? Anything on illegal dumping?

#### Project idea – **Trash Bash** – Direct community groups to annual Trash Bash

- There are several Trash Bash sites in Coalition watersheds
- Additional sites can be added
- Happening March 2021

# Project idea – **Trash Free Texas** – Direct community groups to Trash Free Texas.

- Looking for local governments to add new collection sites; opportunity for cities to partner without hosting their own site
- Increase awareness for more volunteers to see resource
- Gather list of interested organizations

## Project idea – General illegal dumping education

• Delivery – movie theatres, bill boards, boat parade (Kemah July 4, League City Christmas, Dickinson)
