We encouraged departments to proactively request approval to teach certificate programs at a distance. As more courses become available online, there is a risk of students taking most of the credits toward a certificate online and then failing to receive the certificate credential because a certificate program is not approved via distance education. The process for requesting distance approval requires only a program edit in CARS. If a certificate program is 15 credit hours or less, all approvals happen at TAMU and no approval is necessary through THECB.
