Members must submit a typed essay of 1,200 words maximum, double spaced in a font no smaller than 12 explaining their community service campaign. There is no Record Book requirement for this award. Essays will be judged by county officials directly connected with 4-H that do not have children involved in 4-H. Essays are due at the same time as 4-H Award Applications. 2025 RECORD BOOK AWARDS

4-H members who enter a Record Book in the Dallas County 4-H Record Book competition, and score 90 or above, shall receive a 4-H Project Pin.

4-H MEMBERS SUPERSTAR AWARD

This award is to recognize a 4-H member who shows a strong commitment to their club and is very active in all the club's activities. This 4-H member may not be the loudest in the room or the center of attention, but the club would not be the same without them. To be considered for this award, the 4-H member can be nominated by their Club Manager/Leader, Project Leader, or 4-H Staff members. Each club is eligible to have one winner.

2025 LETTERMAN AWARD APPLICATION

All Senior level 4-H members with one or more years in Dallas County 4-H are eligible for this award upon completing the following requirements. Requirements may be completed in one year or over the period of senior enrollment. Members may not count requirements completed as a Junior or Intermediate.

Each year, Dallas County 4-H can select as many members as possible who meet the criteria. This award may be received only once in their 4-H career.

CONGRESSIONAL AWARD

(External Application)

The Congressional Award is the United States Congress's award for young Americans. The program is non-partisan, voluntary, and non-competitive. Young people may register when they turn 13 1/2 years old and must complete their activities by their 24th birthday.

Participants earn Bronze, Silver, and Gold Congressional Award Certificates and Bronze, Silver, and Gold Congressional Award Medals. Each level involves setting goals in four program areas: Voluntary Public Service, Personal Development, Physical Fitness, and Expedition/Exploration. Earning this award is a fun and interesting way to get more involved in something you already enjoy or something you'd like to try for the first time. You move at your own pace – on your own or with your friends. This is not an award for past accomplishments. Instead, you are honored for achieving your own challenging goals after registering for the program.
