Discussion

The workgroup discussed the results from the activity from the February 2011 Dickinson Bayou Watershed Partnership Meeting and how the information could be incorporated in the planning process. The 9 element table was introduced to the group, which will be used as an outline for the planning process. A 9 element table is required for each management measure identified in the Implementation Plan. After being introduced to the 9 element table, the workgroup began identifying potential management measures and information that is needed to develop the components of the 9 element table. After describing the 9 elements table, the group discussed the example tables pulled from the H-GAC Bacteria Implementation Group's Draft I-plan. The group started identifying specific groups of "causes and sources" to be listed in the 9 elements table using the results from the Partnership meeting activity.
