# Hummingbirds

Cardinal Flower (*Lobelia cardinalis*)  
Blue sage (*Salvia azurea*)  
Scarlet sage (*Salvia coccinea*)  
Beebalm (*Monarda citriodora*, *M. fistulosa*, *M. punctata*, *M. lindheimeri*)  
Sunflowers (*Helianthus* sp.)  
Arkansas yucca (*Yucca arkansana*)  
Milkweed (*Asclepias tuberosa*)  
Carolina Larkspur (*Delphinium carolinianum*)  
Columbine (*Aquilegia canadensis* A. *hinckleyana*)  
Cupleaf Penstemon (*P. murrayanus*)  
Foxglove- Purple Beard Tongue (*Penstemon cobaea*)  
Gulf Coast Penstemon (*Penstemon tenuis*)  
Gayfeather (*Liatris* species)  
Fall Obedient Plant (*Physostegia virginiana*)  
Standing Cypress (*Ipomopsis rubra*)  
Lyre leaf sage (*Salvia lyrata*)

### Shrubs: (woody)

Texas Lantana (*Lantana urticoides*)  
Turk's Cap (*Malvaviscus arboreus drummondii*)  
Indigo bush (*Amorpha fruticosa*)  
Eastern Coral Bean (*Erythrina herbacea*)

### Vines:

Coral Honeysuckle (*Lonicera sempervirens*)  
Crossvine (*Bignonia capreolata*)  
Trumpet Creeper (*Campsis radicans*)  
Carolina Jessamine (*Gelsemium sempervirens*)

### Trees:

American Elderberry (*Sambucus canadensis*)  
Flowering Dogwood (*Cornus florida*)  
Eastern Redbud (*Cercis canadensis*)  
Green Hawthorn (*Crateagus viridis*)  
Red Buckeye (*Aesculus pavia*)  
Wild Black Cherry (*Prunus serotina*)
