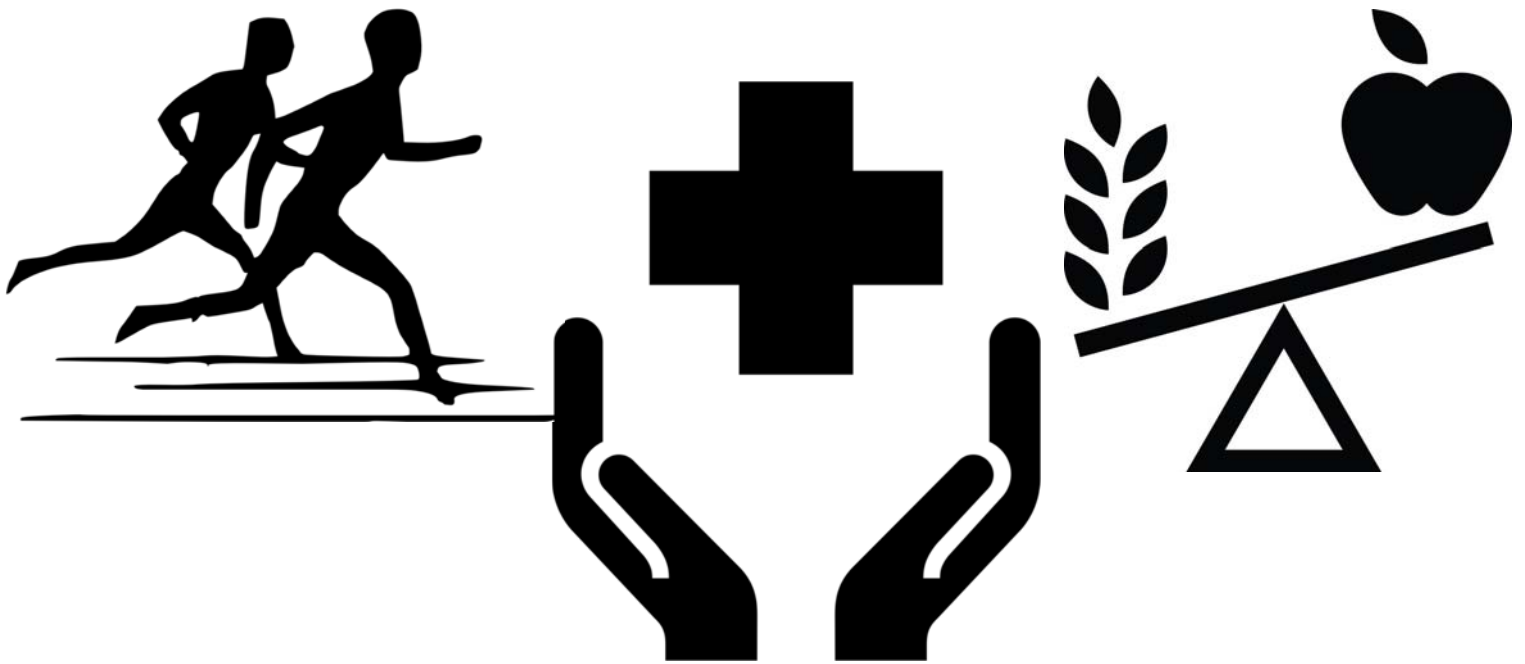

# Star Awards

**Applications due June 18th, 2018**

The Star Awards are a series of awards showing progression of 4-H involvement, including growth and diversification of both the 4-H member and their projects/ events. The series begins with the Rising Star (Step 1), Bronze Star (Step 2), Silver Star (Step 3), “I Dare You” Award (Step 4), and ultimately ending with the Gold Star (Step 5). Each award may only be received once.

**Rising Star** – (JUNIORS) Must be at least 8 and in the 3rd grade but not over 10 as of Aug. 31 of current 4-H year and must have completed at least one year in 4-H.

**Bronze Star** – (INTERMEDIATE) Must be 11 years old but not over 13 as of Aug. 31 of current 4-H year and must have completed at least 2 years in 4-H.

**Silver Star** – Applicants must be at least 14 years of age but not over 19 as of Aug. 31 of the current 4-H year and have completed at least 3 years in 4-H.

**I Dare You** – Applicant must be at least 15 years of age but not over 19 as of Aug. 31 of the current 4-H year and have completed at least 3 years in 4-H.

**Gold Star** – Must be 15 years of age but not over 19 as of Aug. 31 of the current 4-H year and have completed at least 3 years in 4-H.

# Validation Tag Orders

## *Steers, Heifers, Lambs, and Goats*

### **Heifer Validation**

If you have not validated your heifer before, or if the heifer has been validated but has changed ownership, registration papers must be in the exhibitor's name. If you're not going to the State Fair, there will be another heifer validation in October 2018.

### **Major Show Steer Validation**

Any member who is planning to show a steer at the major shows must complete the validation process, including ordering tags and coming to validation.

### **State Fair Lamb and Goat Validation**

Any member who would like to show a lamb or goat at the State Fair of Texas must complete the validation process, including ordering tags and coming to validation. TLBA tags must be in lamb's ears before it can be marked on the validation form.

**Price for late tag orders is now \$27 per tag**

**Late deadline is June 1st, 2018!**

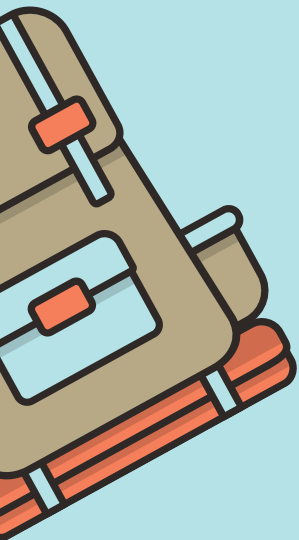

# 2018 Poultry Institute for Youth

## When?

The 2018 Poultry Institute for Youth will be held **Sunday, June 10 through Tuesday, June 12, 2018** at Texas A&M University in College Station, Texas.

## What is the Poultry Institute?

The Institute is a 3 day camp for students with an interest in the poultry industry. Students will attend mini lectures taught by Texas A&M University staff on topics such as anatomy, embryology, immunology, nutrition and processing. Students will also participate in field trips to poultry facilities.



## Who is Eligible?

Students who have an interest in poultry and will be enrolled in the Fall 2018 semester as a high school junior, senior, or college freshman are eligible to apply to attend the Poultry Institute for Youth.



## How do I Apply?

## How much does it Cost?

A registration fee of \$50 will be required for each participant that is selected to attend the Institute. This fee is to be paid upon acceptance to the program. Registration fees will be paid online once students receive their acceptance packets. **Do not send money with the application.** All other expenses, except transportation to and from College Station, will be covered by the sponsorship of the U.S. Poultry and Egg Association.

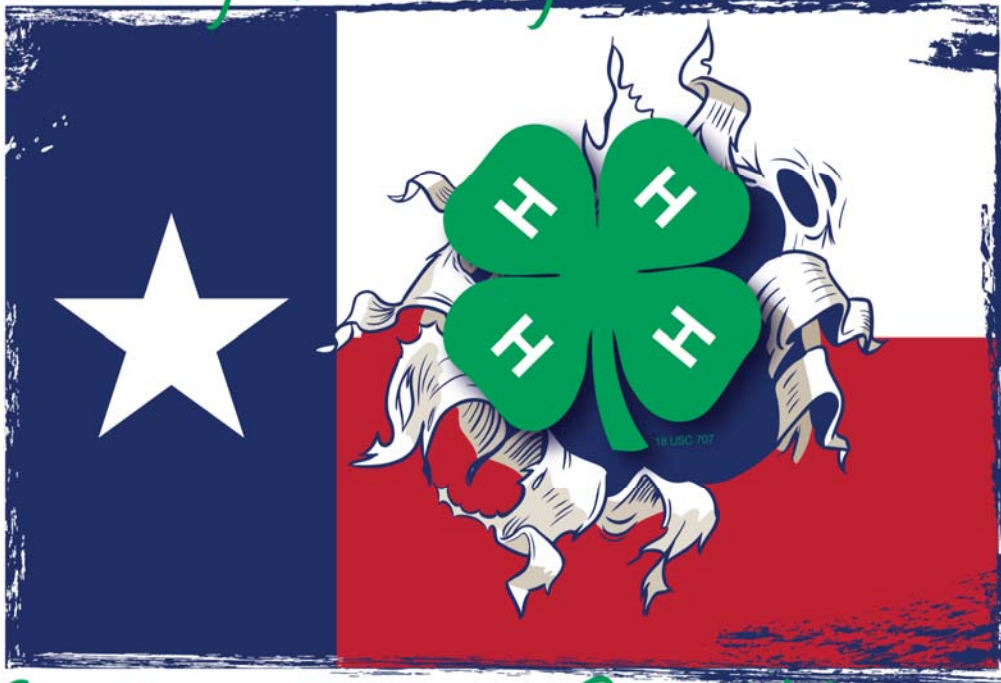

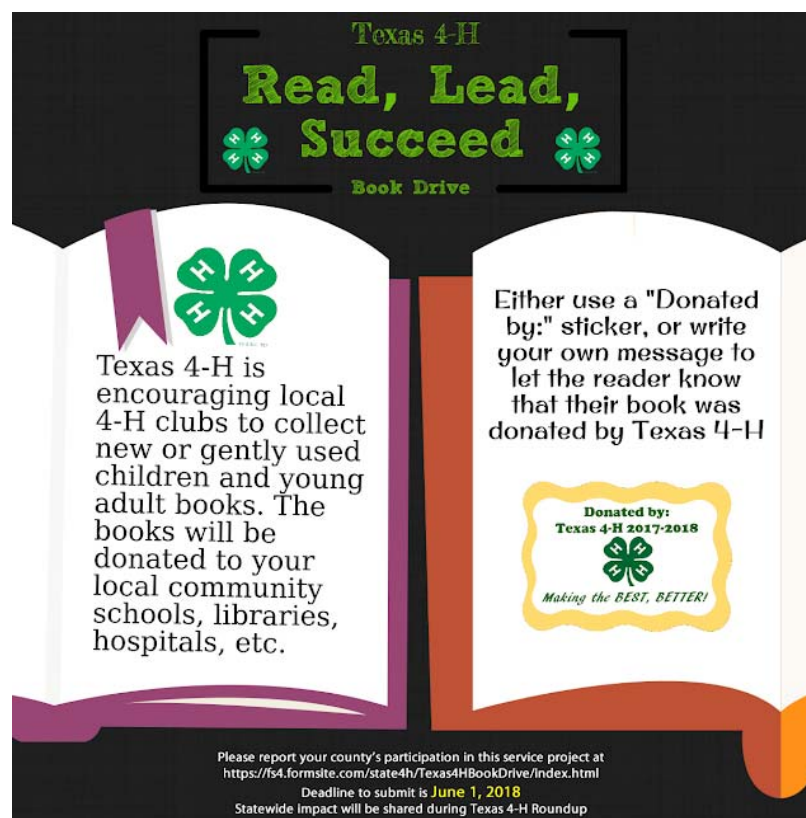
