## Domestic and International Experience

Ambassadors have the opportunity to apply to attend either a Domestic or International learning experience in alternating years. These trips allow Ambassadors to see first-hand the differences in challenges, characteristics and diverse atmospheres associated with agriculture abroad and even in our own country. In June 2018, selected Ambassadors visited Uruguay and Argentina. In August 2019 and August 2021, Ambassadors visited the West Coast and East Coast to increase awareness of immense challenges these states face, such as regulations and

animal rights concerns.
