- 3. All nominees shall have at least one more year left in high school.
- 4. All nominees must have at least three years of 4-H club membership, including the current year. All candidates must have participated in a District 4-H Council meeting of the current 4-H year (September 11, 2021 or January 3, 2022-online). They do not have to attend as a voting delegate from their respective county.
- 5. An officer is not eligible to serve in the same office for consecutive terms.
- 6. Nominees for office shall be members of their County 4-H Program, be recommended by their County Extension Agent, and have served a term of office on their county's 4-H Council, a TASK Force, or Ambassador Program.
- 7. There shall only be two officers elected to district council from any one county.
