2023 PECAN FUNDRAISER

RULES AND GUIDELINES



1. There will be two orders placed for the pecan and peanut fundraising sales event - October (orders will arrive before Thanksgiving) and November (orders will arrive before Christmas).
2. Club Summary Order Form and a club check from the first sale will be due to the Extension Office by 4:00 P.M. on October 17th. Club Summary Order Form and a club check for the second sale will be due to the Extension Office by 4:00 P.M. on November 14th. Additionally, the Summary of Sales Form (list the individuals who sold \$1,000.00 or more) will need to be submitted on or before the second order is due to the Extension Office.
3. For members and clubs that are unable to sell due to nut allergies: Donations collected will count towards an individual's jacket eligibility and the club's 10% incentive.
4. Clubs, please use the supplied Club Summary Order Form when turning in your orders to ensure your order and a dollar amount is correct. They must be turned in to the Extension Office in person by the Pecan Chairman from each club. No phone in orders will be accepted. Late sales will be taken, but they will be placed with the next sale. If it is the final sale, late sales may be taken from the office overstock, if available. It is first come, first serve basis. These sales will not be credited toward your total sales 10% return incentive.
5. How to receive the 10% incentive for your club:
 - Turn in one sale summary sheet per club at each order.
 - Pay for pecans with 1 club check when order is placed. If your club does not have a bank account, please contact Danielle McLure at the Extension Office.
 - Make checks payable to Fort Bend 4-H Program.
 - Pick up pecans within a three day period after being contacted by the Extension Office.
 - Clubs who fail to comply with these four conditions will forfeit their 10% of sales.
6. An additional monetary incentive will be earned by the top three selling clubs.
 - Top Club will receive an additional \$300.00 and the traveling trophy at the awards program.
 - Second will receive an additional \$200.00
 - Third will receive an additional \$100.00
7. Checks that are not claimed and or deposited within ninety days of issuance will be voided and not reissued.
8. **Any club member who reaches \$1,000.00 or more in sells and or donations will receive a Fort Bend County 4-H Jacket at the Annual 4-H Awards Banquet!**
