Council Officer Elections will take place at the County Officer Training July 31, 2018

Qualifications: According to the By-laws the applicant for Chairman and 1st Vice Chairman must have two years of 4-H membership and be 14 years of age or not be 19 years of age before September 1, 2018. All officers shall have at least one year left in high school. All officer candidates must be eligible for membership in the Harris County 4-H County Council members and *must have attended -2- Youth Leadership Council meetings in the current year **(we will suspend this requirement for this year only.)*

Limitations: No more than two officers from any one 4-H club or the same family can be elected and the Chairman and 1st Vice Chairman cannot be from the same 4-H club.

Responsibilities: The term of office is September 1 of current year to August 31 of the next year. Applicants for Chairman and District 9 Delegate should be willing to represent Harris County 4-H on the District 9 4-H Council and attend the two district Council meetings. They should also be willing to attend District 9 4-H Leadership Lab in June and represent Harris County 4-H during the District 9 4-H Council officer elections. Finally, all officers are expected to attend Harris Youth Leadership Council meetings and perform their duties as prescribed in the officer handbook.
