4-H Members can receive points for participating in 4-H activities for the year and be awarded at the end of the 4-H year for their efforts. Every time a member participates in a county or district level event or activity they can receive points going toward their "Outstanding Member Awards."

- 1. Must be an enrolled 4-H Member to receive points.
- Points will be recorded via sign-in sheets, completion on contests and activities, and recorded involvement with activity/ event.
- Points will not be awarded to an individual who does not follow the rules of the event/contest.
- 4. More points will be awarded to those who place in an event.
- 5. More points can be earned if you are attending as a youth volunteer.

Examples on how to get points:

- County Council Meetings (15 points)
- Monthly Spotlight Program (30 points)
- Monthly Contests (10 points)
- Round-Up (40 points)
- Workshops (20 points)
- Trainings (15 points)

Those who receive 200 points will get a Plaque and 4-H Prize!


