

## **Dog Validation**

Texas 4-H Dog Show will be held on July 7-9, 2022 at the Montgomery County Fairgrounds in Conroe, Texas. To be eligible for this show, dogs must be validated by January 10, 2022 in 4-H Online.

Video instructions are available at <u>https://youtu.be/3NzoljK9Pco</u>. 2022 Texas 4-H Dog Show Rule Book will be posted <u>https://texas4-h.tamu.edu/projects/dog-care-</u> <u>training/</u> soon. The 2021 Rule Book is currently available. There will be some minor changes in the regular portion of the show. We are working on an NEW Dog Olympics program for members to exhibit their training skills in a different way.

We strongly encourage members to validate their dogs even if they are not sure they will be participating in the Texas 4-H Dog Show. Completing the FREE validation process before January 10th will give them until entries are due in May to make a final decision.

There will be a couple of opportunities to practice with your dog whether you validated or not:

- Montgomery County 4-H Dog Show will be February 5, 2022 at the Montgomery County Fairgrounds in Conroe, Texas
- Brazos County 4-H Dog Show will be February 12, 2022 at the Kurten Community Center
- Wise County is tentatively scheduled for June 18, 2022

For youth to be eligible to show their dogs, they must submit validate them – there is not a charge.

  Junior distance: 9 meters. Intermediate/Senior distance: 18 meters

#### Competition Open To:

- BB Gun: Youth 8 years old (and in 3<sup>rd</sup> grade) to 15 years old (15 y.o.s may compete if their 16<sup>th</sup> birthday occurs after 1<sup>st</sup> day of 2022 Daisy Nationals). Limit: 60 competitors
