

Global Leadership Opportunities Beyond Education, GLOBE, is a multi-faceted program for 4-H members in grades 7-11. GLOBE prepares 4-H youth to step out of their comfort zone and see the world from a different perspective. GLOBE is a year-long program where youth participate in tow educational programs, held November 11-13, 2022 and January 14, 2023, and four online webinars. Participants are required to make two educational presentations and to provide leadership for a service-learning project in their community. GLOBE's final activity, a week-long immersive program in Costa Rica June 25-July 1, 2023, brings it all together for those that have completed all of the previously mentioned components.

Applications for the various GLOBE programs are now open through October 10th

but limited to 25 youth, so encourage your youth to apply now, HERE.



The County Extension Agents in Titus and Coryell Counties are working together to provide an online educational opportunity for youth involved in the range and plant science project area to gain valuable experience and practice. The virtual event will be held Saturday, October 15th, from 9-11 AM on judgingcard.com. All Texas 4-H and Texas FFA members are invited to participate in the following age divisions: Junior, 3rd - 8th grade and Senior, 9th - 12th grade. Entry fees are \$5 per individual or \$20 per team. Registration is now open and closes on October 7th. They are asking coaches, teachers and agents to proctor their own students and we hope that each participant will do their very best work on their own to test the knowledge they have learned through this project area.

WHAT TO EXPECT

Competitors will participate in a judged poster presentation showcasing their solutions to a selected topic impacting their school or community. Students will also attend workshops and activities hosted by community experts and network with peers to build a community of scholars.

TOPICS

- 1. Addressing gender, cultural and economic discrimination of area high school students
- 2. Managing water scarcity and access to safe potable drinking water
- 3. Raising awareness of food and water safety (ie: proper food handling, recognizing safe drinking water, etc.)
- 4. Reducing incidences of communicable diseases amongst high school students (ie: cold, flu, mono, HPV, HIV etc.)
- 5. Improving access to safe food supplies for local citizens (decreasing food deserts)
- 6. Ensuring equal access to and protection of secondary educational rights
- 7. Preventing and reducing incidences of dietary diseases (ie: obesity, heart disease, diabetes, etc.)

Entry Submission Rules & Guidelines:

- Must be a 4-H member (single entry submission)
- Can use two ink colors in addition to the color of the shirt. Example: If the
 design calls for red, white and blue, one of those colors should be the color of
 the shirt. Do not select white as the shirt color choice.
- The design should fit on the front side of the t-shirt (12 inch design maximum)
- Be creative and develop an original design
- Simple designs are more effective and easier to screen print. Designs may have to be modified slightly to include the proper clover logo and to clean up details.
- Entries should be emailed to Cory.hundl@ag.tamu.edu by February 15, 2023
- · Must be JPEG or PNG format
- · Include the following in your email:

 - Grade
 - County
 - o Attach Image/Design
- Entries will be judged based on 4-H Age Divisions

 - o Junior (3rd 5th)
 - Intermediate (6th 8th)




