





Major Livestock Show Validation Information

This is just a reminder to start thinking about your 4-H members participation in Major Livestock Shows for Fall 2021 and Spring 2022. This is not a decision that you can make last minute. Tags are ordered months in advance and cannot be obtained last minute. Tags also cannot be obtained from other counties, if you are a Liberty County exhibitor, they must be ordered through the Liberty County Extension Office. Tags and UINS must be paid for at time of order. Please do not show up to validation expecting a tag or UIN if you did not pre-order and pay. **It is never too early to contact the office and put your name on the list for major tags.** Payment for tags or UINS is due prior to tags being ordered by the Extension Office. 


