Major Livestock Show Validation Information

This is just a reminder to start thinking about your participation in Major Livestock Shows for Fall 2023 and Spring 2024. This is not a decision that you can make last minute. Tags are ordered months in advance and cannot be obtained last minute. Tags also cannot be obtained from other counties, if you are a Liberty County exhibitor, they must be ordered through the Liberty County Extension Office. Tags must be paid for at time of order. Please do not show up to validation expecting a tag if you did not pre-order and pay. **It is never too early to contact the office and put your name on the list for major tags.** Payment for tags are due prior to tags being ordered by the Extension Office. Tag Order and Validation Schedule:

April

- Major Steer tag orders due (this will be for State Fair 2023 and all Spring 2024 Major Shows, there is only 1 Steer validation each year)
- Heifer tag orders due (This will validate a heifer for her entire show career, unless the heifer changes ownership.)
- State Fair 2023 Lamb and Goat orders due
- State Fair 2023 Swine tag orders due

September

- Spring Heifer tag orders due (for shows beginning in Spring 2024)
- Swine tag orders due (for Spring 2024 Major Shows)

June

- State steer validation (this will be for State Fair 2023 and all Spring 2024 Major Shows)
- State Fair 2023 Lamb, Goat, and Swine Validation
- Fall heifer validation (for all shows starting in Fall 2023 and after)

October

- Spring Heifer Validation (for shows beginning in Spring 2024)
- State Lamb and Goat Validation (for Spring 2024 Major Shows)

August

- Lamb and goat tag orders due (for Spring 2024 Major Shows)

November

- State Swine Validation (for Spring 2024 Major Shows)
