- 4. Adhere to Liberty County 4-H Ambassador Policy; including age, training, and selection process.
- 5. Dress in required, appropriate Ambassador attire that provides a positive image of 4-H for each official event.
- 6. Be responsible to know and use language and manners appropriate for 4-H.
- 7. Be in the assigned role/program/responsibility/event area at all times.
- 8. Know that the use of tobacco, alcohol, and non-prescription drugs are illegal and prohibited in all 4-H events.
- 9. Practice respect and care of all property used. You will be personally responsible for any damage caused as result of your behavior and actions.
- 10. Represent the Liberty County, Texas and National 4-H Program with pride and dignity.
