Liberty County 4-H Continuing Education Scholarship Criteria 2025

***A minimum of 1 \$500 scholarship will be awarded. Number may vary depending on number of applicants. ***

The Liberty County 4-H Continuing Education Scholarship is open to a past member of the Liberty County 4-H program who has completed 24 or more hours of college work toward a bachelor's degree and has continued to exhibit leadership abilities while in college. The candidate must be enrolled as a full-time student (minimum of 12 hours per semester).

The candidate **MUST** submit:

- 1. Most recent transcript.
- 2. A completed typewritten application for scholarship. No handwritten application will be judged.

The completed scholarship application must be delivered to the Extension office by June 2, 2025.

Any candidate who does not submit all of these requirements will be disqualified.

Selection will be based on participation in the Liberty County 4-H program, scholarship, leadership, and citizenship. Winners will be announced at the Liberty County 4-H Awards Banquet in August.

The scholarship funds will be sent to the college or university after proof of registration and the ADDRESS of the Financial Aid Office have been submitted. Funds will be sent to the college where the recipient is enrolled for 12 or more semester hours and is in good standing academically.

In order for the scholarship check to be released, the following steps must be followed:

- 1. Send a copy of the past semester's transcript to the Extension Office.
- 2. Send a copy of your schedule and/or fee statement for the Fall 2024 semester to the Extension Office.
- 3. Make sure the Extension Office has the ADDRESS for the school's Financial Aid Office.

The scholarship will be awarded to an alternate applicant if the applicant does not follow through requesting the scholarship funds within six (6) months of the application deadline.

The completed application and supporting documentation must be turned in to the Extension office by 6-2-2025.
