***UPDATED Information from Texas A&M AgriLife Extension:

Please contact the 4-H office if you need any clarification on the current operating guidelines.

Montgomery County has been designated as a Red Level County.

These guidelines will be in place from December 18, 2020 – January 6, 2021; the situation will be re-evaluated every two weeks.

The guidelines that affect 4-H directly are:

- Group INDOOR events at 25% capacity of space or less are allowed only if social distancing can be practiced. Events must be approved by supervisor through a preparedness plan.
- Group OUTDOOR events may be held with a maximum of 30 people. Events with greater than 30 people must be approved by supervisor through a preparedness plan.
- Face to face group events should be mission critical. Events with priority are ones with time, fiscal and workforce implications.
- No overnight events.

January and February events should have alternate plans in the event the situation does not improve.

This has no bearing on the major livestock shows.
