!!ACADEMIC ELIGIBILITY FORMS

These are **REQUIRED** to be completed by the school and signed by the parent prior to any 4-H member participating in any competitive 4-H activity.

A separate form is required for each competitive event/activity. Forms can be requested & mailed if time is permitted. Should any special arrangements be needed, it must be communicated and approved with the 4-H office.

Eligibility Forms (No Pass, No Play) are ultimately the member's responsibility to complete for any competitive 4-H event regardless of the day of competition. Even if you are not missing school, you still need to turn in an eligibility form.

Forms must be picked up from the 4-H office or they can be mailed if time allows for it. Forms are due back to the 4-H office 1 week prior to participation.
