# IOIN THE CLUB 2022-2023 Member Enrollment

The new 4-H year officially begins on September 1, 2022. Enrollment will open and begin on August 15, 2022

Each year starts out with zero-enrollment. This means all 4-H members, whether new or returning, must complete their enrollment through 4-H Connect to become an active 4-H member.

Returning members do not complete a new profile. You log into your existing profile, update all info, and pay the participation fee. Duplicate profiles will get deleted. Enroll as soon as possible so that you don't miss out on any weekly update emails.

Nobody is too old for 4-H!! Adult volunteers or adults who wish to attend District or State trainings will create/update their profile and pay a yearly \$10 fee (this helps cover the cost of background screenings).

If you have volunteered as a club manager, assistant manager, or a project leader you are required to complete the volunteer enrollment. Please be sure to do this as soon as enrollment opens on Aug. 15th

By not doing so it could hinder your ability to participate in select trainings or events. Volunteers enroll the same way 4-H members complete their enrollment.



# Project Highlight

### **Veterinary Science**



Through 4-H you can go through a veterinary assistant preparatory training program to prepare for a future career as a vet technician.

If you are interested in a career as a veterinarian, start with your veterinary assistant certificate!

The 4-H Veterinary Science Project is a 5 year curriculum based project with 100 lessons and 500 hours of apprenticeship. that gives youth interested in veterinary medicine a chance to work in the field and see if they

would like to pursue it as a career. After a member has completed the program, they may apply to take a test to become a Certified Veterinary Assistant. 4-H members may begin the project at any age, but have to be 16 years old in order to apply to take the test.

The Montgomery County 4-H Dog Project strives to educate youth in the health, grooming, safety, and training of their own personal dog. Members in the project must have a dog of their own, provide proof of vaccinations, and pass a skills test.

Training begins with basic obedience, showmanship and conformation, progresses to rally, then finally agility is added provided that the dog is 18 months or older. Youth can be members of any club to participate in the project. This is a great way to have fun with your dog, gain more knowledge about dog care, make new friends, and learn more about a lifelong career. Beginner training has started for this year, but there are still opportunities to participate.
