Fall 2024 Major Show Entry Night

August 13, 2024 5-7pm

This is the day to do all entries (livestock and non-livestock) for State Fair of Texas, Heart of Texas, and East Texas State Fair.

Ordering tags, validating your animal, and placing turkey and broiler orders only makes your project ELIGIBLE to be entered in one or more of the major livestock shows held in the September/October time frame. The next step is to complete entry forms to determine what animal you are taking to which show and pay your entry fees. A sign-up genius will be sent out to sign up for a time.

What to bring: *4-H member *Parent *4-H Member's Social Security Number

*Valid Quality County Number *Method of Payment (cash or check) *Heifer registration papers *Pure bred gilt papers



All livestock exhibitors are required to complete the education module and test. Exhibitors must be verified once as a Junior (grades 3-5), once as an Intermediate (grades 6-8), and once as a Senior (grades 9-12).
