### Fall 2024 Major Show Entry Night

**August 13, 2024 5-7pm** 

This is the day to do all entries (livestock and non-livestock) for State Fair of Texas, Heart of Texas, and East Texas State Fair.

Ordering tags, validating your animal, and placing turkey and broiler orders only makes your project ELIGIBLE to be entered in one or more of the major livestock shows held in the September/October time frame. The next step is to complete entry forms to determine what animal you are taking to which show and pay your entry fees. A sign-up genius will be sent out to sign up for a time.

What to bring: \*4-H member \*Parent \*4-H Member's Social Security Number

\*Valid Quality County Number \*Method of Payment (cash or check) \*Heifer
registration papers \*Pure bred gilt papers



All livestock exhibitors are required to complete the education module and test. Exhibitors must be verified once as a Junior (grades 3-5), once as an Intermediate (grades 6-8), and once as a Senior (grades 9-12).

### **Enrollment**



The new 4-H year officially begins on September 1, 2024. Enrollment will open and begin on August 15, 2024.

Each year starts out with zero-enrollment. This means all 4-H members, whether new or returning, must complete their enrollment through 4-H Online to become an active 4-H member.

Returning members do not complete a new profile. You log into your existing profile, update all info, and pay the participation fee. Duplicate profiles will get deleted. Enroll as soon as possible so that you don't miss out on any weekly update emails.

If you are 8 years old and going into the 3rd grade, WAIT until September 1st to complete enrollment, so you are not registered as a CLover Kid.

Texas 4-H Connect: https://texas.4honline.com Enrollment will begin on August 15, 2024

Nobody is too old for 4-H!! Adult volunteers or adults who wish to attend District or State trainings will create/update their profile and pay a yearly \$10 fee (this helps cover the cost of background screenings).

If you have volunteered as a club manager, assistant manager, signer on a bank account, or a project leader you are required to complete the volunteer enrollment. Please be sure to do this as soon as enrollment opens on Aug. 15th. Not doing so could hinder your ability to participate in select trainings or events. Volunteers enroll the same way 4-H members complete their enrollment.
