

Building a Search String

Whether you're searching CAB Abstracts, another library database such as Web of Science, or Google Scholar, building a search string will help you refine your search results and spend less time looking for articles.

Step 1: Identify your research question:

Step 2: Circle the 3 or 4 key words/phrases in your research question above.

Step 3: In the table below, list the key words/phrases you circled above. Next, consider any words that might be related to the key words you selected. Write down these synonyms next to each key word in the table.

Step 4: In the space below, write a search string using these synonyms and keywords. Remember to join key words with their synonyms using "OR", and join key words with "AND".
